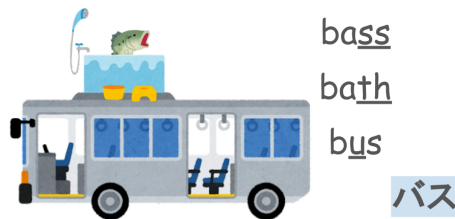


SDC 2024 Classroom Carnival: Sound It Out by Roni Sindac

A. What is phonics and why is it important?

Phonics is one of the ways people learn to read and write—by understanding the relationship between the sounds of the spoken language and the letters (or groups of letters) of the written language.

If one of your goals as an ALT is to improve your students' pronunciation, using *katakana* as a reading guide doesn't help in the long run because the Japanese language has less sounds compared to English.
